RE: Mandatory Medical Requirements

All new candidates are required to complete entry level training and medical requirements before they can achieve the status of "deployable" and be eligible to deploy. These requirements are:

- Current physical on file
 - Urine dip (for specific gravity)
 - Blood Work up which includes:
 - RBC Cholinesterase
 - Heavy Metal Screening
- * Used to establish baseline values to substantiate an exposure to toxic chemicals following a deployment.

 - Tetanus
 - Yellow Fever
 - Hepatitis A & B
